The student is expected to give thoughtful, comprehensive answers to these questions based upon what he learned from watching Conflict: The Biblical Approach DVD and completing the Conflict: The Biblical Approach Study Guide.

This is an essay test; the teacher can decide the appropriate length of the answers based upon the student's age/grade level. We encourage the student to have his Bible available when taking the test and include Scripture references wherever possible.

1. What is the Greek word for love as used in I Corinthians 13, and what type of love does it describe?
2. What gospel truth should a Christian remember as he works through relational conflict with another person? What Scripture verse is this truth based upon?
3. Summarize the four principles for overcoming anger based on Ephesians 4:25-32. Cite the specific verse or verses that support each principle. You may use your Bible.
4. List the seven conditions for confrontation as presented in Chapter 8.

5. According to J.C. Ryle, what are the three defining characteristics of a Christian man (or woman) following after humility?

6. What practices did the early church continually devote itself to? What do we call these practices today and what is their purpose?

7. What were the three most important things you learned from watching this DVD and completing the Study Guide?

8. How will you handle conflict differently based upon what you learned from watching this DVD and completing the Study Guide? Use Scripture to support your answer.
